My parents were Lewis Chan & ~~Sarah~~ Sarah Martha Brown
There were 12 Children 6 girls & 5 boys.

I was born in Rockhampton the 26. 9. 1906

I went to the Drawinga School until I was 13 years old
my first job was ringbarking out at Hillcot for A J
Salisbury, & then after we moved ^{Pettygrove Street} to Goonally &
Wooroonoo doing miles of fencing for 1 shilling & 4 pence
a post + week ends ^{we} shot kangaroos & bears being open
& then when I was about 19 years I got a job ^{season for bears} with
a Drover taking 15,000 sheep from Springsure in to
N.S.W. which lasted a few months

I + J English brought the plant back to Springsure.
I then was employed on Jack Creek Station working
as a Stockman I then got £3. pound a week I worked
there for a couple of years, after leaving there
^{I worked on Goonally}
Dad + I took up ringbarking at Westwood for
Lawrey getting 1/- an acre.

We traveled down by Buggy and when we got to the
Gogango range, our horses would not pull the
buggy up the hills, we had to leave the buggy
and ride on ^{to start} to where we were working,
